

## FAITH & LIFE LECTURE SERIES

The *Faith & Life Lecture Series* provide the opportunity to study a specific topic on an introductory level. Usually these sessions discuss the relationship between Christianity and a particular cultural concept or idea, though they sometimes cover an aspect of Biblical studies, history, or theology. Employing a lecture/discussion format, each session usually lasts an hour and a half and meets once a week for four weeks. The *Lecture Series* require no specific work outside of class, although instructors often provide lists of published material for recommended reading.
