TILL DEATH DO US PART

Rom. 7:1 Or do you not know, brothers—for I am speaking to those who know the law—that the law is binding on a person only as long as he lives? ² For a married woman is bound by law to her husband while he lives, but if her husband dies she is released from the law of marriage.

A SECOND PURPOSE

Gen. 2:18 Then the LORD God said, "It is not good that the man should be alone; I will make him a helper fit for him"... ²⁰ The man gave names to all livestock and to the birds of the heavens and to every beast of the field. But for Adam there was not found a helper fit for him. ²¹ So the Lord God caused a deep sleep to fall upon the man, and while he slept took one of his ribs and closed up its place with flesh. ²² And the rib that the LORD God had taken from the man he made into a woman and brought her to the man. ²³ Then the man said, "This at last is bone of my bones and flesh of my flesh; she shall be called Woman, because she was taken out of Man." ²⁴ Therefore a man shall leave his father and his mother and hold fast to his wife, and they shall become one flesh.

A THIRD PURPOSE

1Cor. 7:1 Now concerning the matters about which you wrote: "It is good for a man not to have sexual relations with a woman." 2 But because of the temptation to sexual immorality, each man should have his own wife and each woman her own husband. ³ The husband should give to his wife her conjugal rights, and likewise the wife to her husband. ⁴ For the wife does not have authority over her own body, but the husband does. Likewise the husband does not have authority over his own body, but the wife does. ⁵ Do not deprive one another, except perhaps by agreement for a limited time, that you may devote yourselves to prayer; but then come together again, so that Satan may not tempt you because of your lack of self-control.

THE THREE PURPOSES OF MARRIAGE

BCP 1662

- **First**, it was ordained for the procreation of children, to be brought up in the fear and nurture of the Lord, and to the praise of his holy Name.
- Secondly, it was ordained for a remedy against sin, and to avoid fornication; that such persons as have not the gift of continency might marry, and keep themselves undefiled members of Christ's body.
- Thirdly, it was ordained for the mutual society, help, and comfort, that the one ought to have of the other, both in prosperity and adversity.

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BCP 1979 The union of husband and wife in heart, body, and mind is intended by God

- for their mutual joy;
- for the help and comfort given one another in prosperity and adversity;
- and, when it is God's will, for the procreation of children and their nurture in the knowledge and love of the Lord.

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sexual purity

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"What a world it wd. be if most of the people we met were perpetually in this ['being-inlove'] trance! The prayer book therefore begins with something universal and solid-the biological aspect. No one is going to deny that the biological end of the sexual functions is offspring. And this is, on any sane view, of more importance than the feelings of the parents. Your descendants may be alive a million years hence and may number tens of thousands. In this regard marriages are the fountains of History" (C. S. Lewis, letter to Mary Neylan, April 18, 1940).


THIS AGE

- That "being fruitful and multiplying and filling the earth" is the first purpose of a man and woman becoming "one flesh" in Scripture.
- That since this purpose ends with the defeat of death and the resurrection of the body, there is no marriage in the age to come.

SO WHAT HAVE WE LEARNED?

- That marriage is also intended for companionship and partnership in a "oneflesh" union that brings husband and wife together in fidelity and love.
- That just as humans were created in the image of God, so marriage was created in the image of God's relationship with his people.
- That the promises of marital union and fruitfulness are both fulfilled in the marriage of God's people with God-in-Christ.
- That there is thus an inward and outward dimension in our human marriages and in our union with Christ.

THE SHINING BARRIER (SHELDON & DAVY)

- "The Shining Barrier—the shield around our love. A walled garden. A fence around a young tree to keep the deer from nibbling it. A fortified place with the walls and watchtowers gleaming white like the cliffs of England. The Shining Barrier—we called it so from the first—protecting the great tree of our love" (*A Severe Mercy*, 36).
- "We turned away from [self], turned away because we loved our love. And we were determined that it should endure. Creeping separateness and sharing were opposite sides of one coin. We rejected separate activities, whether bridge or shooting or sailing, because they would lead to creeping separateness; on the other hand, if one of us like anything, the other, in the name of sharing, must learn to like it too" (37).

THE SHINING BARRIER (LEWIS'S RESPONSE)

- Sheldon Vanauken: "It was now that we reexamined our doubts about children. If children could be raised by a nanny, we sharing them for a few hours each day, or even if we were farmers, children might be a good. But in the pattern of modern life, where they became the centre for the woman, they were separating. We would not have children" (37).
- C.S. Lewis to Sheldon, Aug 5, 1955: "Then come to Christians. They wd. of course agree that man & wife are 'one flesh': they wd. perhaps admit that this was most admirably realized by Jean and you. But surely they wd. add that this One Flesh must not (and in the long run cannot) 'live to itself' any more than the single individual. It was not made, any more than he, to be its own End. It was made for God and (in Him) for its neighbors—first and foremost among them the children it ought to have produced."

BOOK OF COMMON PRAYER 2019

The union of husband and wife in heart, body, and mind was ordained by God: for the procreation of children and their nurture in the knowledge and love of the Lord; for mutual joy, and for the help and comfort given one another in prosperity and adversity; to maintain purity, so that husbands and wives, with all the household of God, might serve as holy and undefiled members of the Body of Christ; and for the upbuilding of Christ's kingdom in family, church, and society, to the praise of his holy Name.

FOR THE LIFE OF THE WORLD

The final point is this: some of us are married and some are not. Some of us are called to be priests and ministers and some are not. But the sacraments of matrimony and priesthood concern all of us, because they concern our life as vocation. The meaning, the essence, and the end of all vocation is the mystery of Christ and the Church. It is through the Church that each one of us finds that the vocation of all vocations is to follow Christ in the fullness of His priesthood: in His love for man and the world, His love for their ultimate fulfillment in the abundant life of the Kingdom" (Alexander Schmemann, *For the Life of the World*, 94).
